What is the plan?

The restoration is a three-phase project, beginning with architectural planning. Phase II is the restoration and the final phase will be courthouse landscaping plans and Main Street development.

What will the restoration cost?

The estimated total cost to return the courthouse to its original beauty and function is approximately \$5 million.

Where will the funds come from?

Currently Randall County has received \$322,365 in grant money from the Texas Historical Commission for the architectural plans.

In 2005 the county will apply for \$4 million for Phase II funding through the Texas Historical Courthouse Program. This phase of the grant is an 80/20 match.

Other grants are being sought as a source of revenue, as are donations from corporations, businesses and individuals.

What is the goal?

The money we must raise to restore this historic landmark is \$850,000. However, The Randall County Courthouse Restoration Fund Board's goal is to raise enough money to ensure the building's prominence for future generations. By raising more than \$1 million, future maintenance will not be a political platform or tax concern.
